The Charity

Rainbow House was founded in April 2001 by a mother of two children who have a rare genetic life threatening disorder which has disabled them for life. Her vision was to establish a centre which offered services for children with disabilities and support for their families.

Rainbow House was originally opened to provide services for children in the Lancashire area, but demand has grown dramatically since its inception and the charity now has a further centre, The Legacy, which specialises in supporting pre-school children and their families. Together the centres serve more than 100 children from across the North West of England, from Lancashire to North Wales, and Manchester to Merseyside. We also offer an outreach service for children in Cumbria.

What We Do

The Legacy Rainbow House is dedicated to improving the lives of children with disabilities. We specialise in providing a range of educational services for children with neurological problems and conditions such as cerebral palsy, genetic and metabolic conditions, and children with acquired brain injuries. Some of the children who attend also have undiagnosed neurological problems.

Our approach is based on the principles of Conductive Education which aims to teach children life enhancing techniques through personally formulated goals and milestones, so that they can live more independent lives within the community.

Jules's Story

Jules was developing normally until, when he was nearly two years old, he contracted encephalitis. As a result of this brain injury, Jules lost all his previously learnt abilities and he became very severely cognitively and physically disabled.

Shortly after leaving hospital, Jules started to attend The Legacy Rainbow House to participate in weekly sessions of Conductive Education. During these sessions he participates in activities to develop his cognitive, social, emotional and physical skills. He works in a group of children and is beginning to learn how to interact and play with other children again.

Over the past year, Jules has started to relearn some of the abilities which he had lost. He now eats and drinks age appropriately and is able to sit for a few minutes with minimal help. He is able to roll by himself and he enjoys moving around at home in this way. His head control has improved and he can grasp and hold things in his hands.

A year ago he started learning to walk again and is now able to take independent steps with less manual help.
